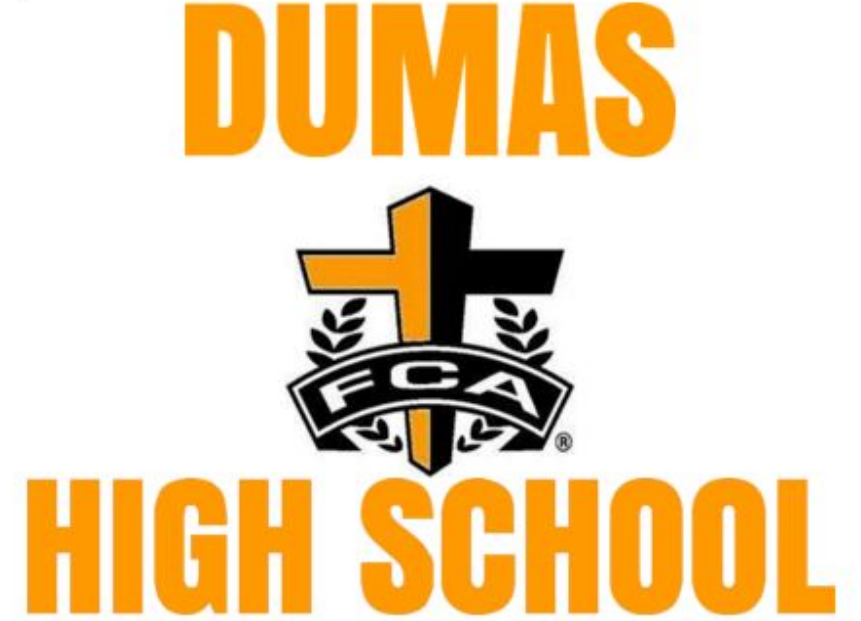
Leo Club will meet every
