Endorsements

With few exceptions, all students will be required to earn an endorsement in one of the following areas:

1. Arts & Humanities
2. Business & Industry
3. STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math)
4. Public Services
5. Multidisciplinary Studies

Arts & Humanities

- Art I, II, III, & IV
- Choir I, II, III, & IV
- Band I, II, III, & IV
- Theater I, II, III, & IV

Business & Industry

- Agricultural & Natural Resources (Ag, Livestock, Vet Med)
- Manufacturing (Welding & Manufacturing)
- Architecture & Construction (Construction Tech)
- Technology (Computers)
- Finance (Accounting & Business)

STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math

- MATH - 5 Math credits including: Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, and 2 additional advanced Math courses
- SCIENCE - 5 Science credits including: Biology, Physics, Chemistry, and 2 additional advanced Science courses
- MATH / SCIENCE – Algebra II, Chemistry, Physics, and 3 additional advanced credits from Math or Science

Public Service

- Health Science (Medical)
- Human Service (Cosmetology)
- Human Service (Child Development)



Multidisciplinary

- 4 credits in each of the foundation subject areas to include English IV, Chemistry and/or Physics

What To Expect As Freshmen
