

STIPENDS FOR ADVANCED DEGREES AND SPECIALIZED TRAINING DEA-R7

The District will provide stipends for the following groups of employees because they hold advanced degrees, have other specialized training, or their particular job demands unique abilities. The stipends listed below are annual amounts and shall be prorated for those employees who do not work a full schedule. Amounts of \$1,000 or more annually will be added to the employees pay and paid out over the year. Amounts of less than \$1,000 annually will be paid in April in one lump sum.

Certified teacher, counselor, librarian, registered nurse with Master’s degree who began work before July 1, 2013 and has been continuously employed since	\$2,000
Certified teacher, counselor, librarian, registered nurse with Master’s degree who began work after July 1, 2013	\$1,000
Certified classroom teacher hired before July 1, 2013 who teaches in the subject discipline in which they hold their Master’s degree for no less than 50% of the instructional day. Transcript must reflect a minimum of 18 credit hours in the specific subject discipline. The classes taught to qualify for the stipend must be subject discipline specific with respect to the course title and/or content of the course as outlined in TEKS.	\$1000

Cactus Elementary assignment - full time staff	\$ 750
Life Skills, BAC and PPCD certified classroom teacher	\$4,000
Life Skills, BAC and PPCD Teaching Assistant	\$2.03/hour
Certified classroom teacher who teaches a bilingual class	\$2,000
