

**MAINTENANCE, TRANSPORTATION, AND CUSTODIAL STAFF
DRESS CODE****DH-R3**

- Men shall wear socks with shoes
- Men shall not wear their hair tied back in any manner nor shall the hair length extend beyond the bottom of the shirt collar.
- Hair must be clean, neat, and combed.
- Facial hair shall not exceed one inch in length and will be groomed and neat in appearance.
- All clothing shall be clean, neat, in good condition.
- Clothing shall fit properly.
- Belts will be worn with clothing so designed for belts.
- Underwear shall not be visible at any time.
- Exposure of cleavage is unacceptable at any time.
- Tattoos and piercings must not be visible. The only exception is that females may have pierced ears.
- Sleeveless garments are not allowed.
- Shirts not tucked in must have a straight hem.
- Shirts must have a collar. (See exceptions below)
- Jeans are acceptable and shall be clean and in good condition.
- Knee length shorts are acceptable only when school is not in session and must extend to the top of the knee cap.
- Skirts and dresses must extend to the top of the knee cap.
- Jogging suits, wind suits or other athletic type of apparel shall not be worn.

Exceptions:

Summer – T-shirts may be worn in the summer when school is not in session. This does not apply to bus drivers who drive students in the summer.

Friday Spirit Days - Dumas School Spirit t-shirts will be allowed on Fridays only. Shirts must be in school colors (orange, black, white, or gray) and promote Dumas ISD schools.
