Math

District Guidelines on Math Facts for 1st and 2nd Grade

Facts test in 1st grade are not timed. Facts should go through sums of 10 and decomposing numbers leading to a ten (ex: $6 + 8 = 6 + 6 + 2$ or $6 + 4 + 4$). Manipulatives may be used all year. If you choose to grade facts tests, there can be one grade per 6 weeks based on 100% scale, no rubric. Math fact practice, with concrete and pictorial models, will be tested within the six weeks assessments.

Facts test in 2nd grade will not be timed in the 1st semester and students may use manipulatives. Facts should go through sums of 20. Facts test in the 2nd semester are timed without manipulatives except for special circumstances. Math fact practice will be tested (2 minutes for 20 problems) within the six weeks assessments.
